- Includes reimbursement provisions if employment is voluntarily terminated within a set time period, depending on funding amount

RELOCATION/MOVING ALLOWANCE

- Offered as a lump sum payment
- Includes reimbursement provisions if employement is voluntarily terminated within a set time period, depending on funding amount

WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT

- Scholarships or loans/forgivable loans offered to eligible students
 - Requires student to enter Power Line and Construction and Maintenance program at a qualifying institution
 - Includes contract position at customer municipal utility for set time period, depending on education completion and funding amount

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

 Approved on-site apprentice/journeyman lineworker training program eligible for 25% cost reimbursement

For union job positions, the municipal utility must contact the union and provide written documentation that Heartland's funding will adhere to any rules set forth by the acting union.
